

Appendix 8- Community Infrastructure Projects

Bletchingdon and Hampton Gay and Poyle Neighbourhood Development Plan

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group, taking account of Neighbourhood Plan resident consultation and in discussion with the Parish Council/ Meetings, has identified a series of priority improvement projects in relation to community infrastructure. These are set out here to offer further detail as to the type of improvements that may be sought via **Policy F1 – Community facilities**.

Project (number and title)	Description	Timescale	Indicative cost
1. Children's play area	To establish a play area for children in the North of the village on the site of the planned development. This would be similar to the existing one in the South.	Within the timescale of the development.	Funded by the developer.
2. A community orchard	To establish a community run orchard on a suitable site within the village. This would be run by a voluntary village group.	Next three years	If the land is provided free of charge – c.£5000 for trees and fencing.
3. A layby on Station Road.	To create additional off-road parking, within the vicinity of the public house.	Next three years	Unknown, but could be funded by developer contributions.
4. Hard surface footpaths to neighbouring villages.	To upgrade existing footpath access to Kirtlington and Hampton Poyle. This could also include creating a new footpath in the case of Kirtlington.	Next three years	Unknown, but could be funded by developer or other contributions.
